

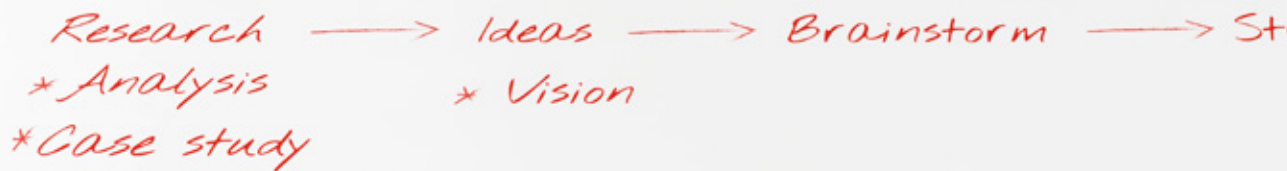

But what are the 3 vital tasks to take care of when you first get going?

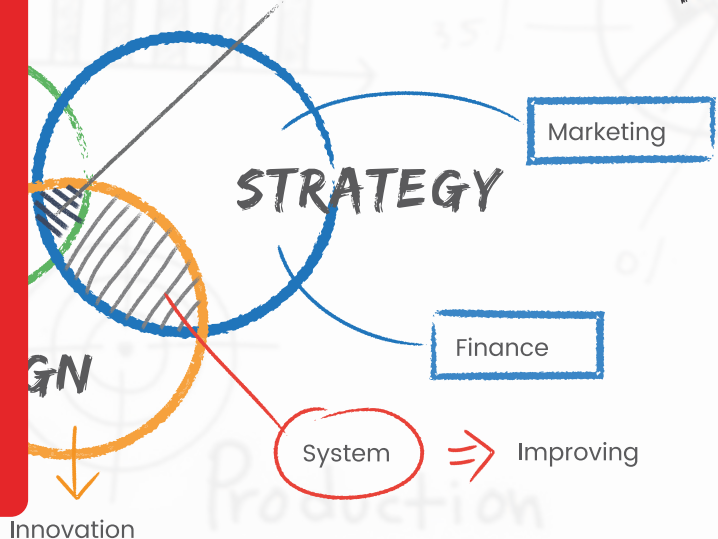
CREATE A STRONG BUSINESS PLAN
